

Thierry Trouvé reappointed as CEO of GRTgaz

On 7 May 2021, the Board of Directors reappointed Thierry Trouvé as Chief Executive Officer of GRTgaz for a term of office of four years. This appointment was approved by the Energy Regulatory Commission in accordance with the French Energy Code.

In line with the expectations of its stakeholders and its new core purpose – “Together, we enable an energy future that is safe, affordable and climate neutral”¹ – GRTgaz is stepping up its commitment to the energy transition.

“The target of a 100% carbon-neutral gas system by 2050 will require the renewable gas sectors to become more competitive, and the ability to convert part of the existing network to transport hydrogen. The central issue for the next few years, as shown by our CAP24 project, is to transform GRTgaz to meet the challenge of the third gas revolution that is currently underway,” stated Thierry Trouvé.



Thierry Trouvé, 59, Specialist Engineer and a member of the Corps des Mines, has been CEO of GRTgaz since 26 April 2013. He began his career at the Ministry of Defence before holding various positions at the Paris Transport Authority (1990) and then at the Department of Industry (1996). In 2000, he joined the French Energy Regulatory Commission (CRE) as Director of the Electricity Market and Public Utilities Division. In 2003, he was appointed Director of Pollution and Risk Prevention Operations responsible for major risks within the Ministry of Ecology and Sustainable Development. In 2006, he joined GRTgaz as Deputy CEO. He was appointed CEO of Elengy in 2009. In 2013, he was appointed CEO of GRTgaz.

Thierry Trouvé is a Knight of the French Legion of Honour and a Knight of the French National Order of Merit.

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GRTgaz est l'un des leaders européens du transport de gaz et un expert mondial des systèmes gaziers. En France, l'entreprise exploite plus de 32 000 km de canalisations enterrées pour transporter le gaz des fournisseurs vers les consommateurs raccordés à son réseau (gestionnaires des distributions publiques qui desservent les communes, centrales de production d'électricité et plus de 700 sites industriels). GRTgaz assure des missions de service public visant à garantir la continuité d'acheminement et propose à ses clients des prestations d'accès au réseau et d'amélioration de leur performance énergétique. Avec ses filiales Elengy, leader des services de terminaux méthaniers en Europe, et GRTgaz Deutschland, opérateur du réseau de transport MEGAL en Allemagne, GRTgaz joue un rôle clé sur la scène européenne des infrastructures gazières et exporte ses savoir-faire à l'international notamment grâce aux prestations développées par son centre de recherche, RICE (Research & Innovation Center for Energy). Acteur de la transition énergétique, GRTgaz investit dans des solutions innovantes pour accueillir sur son réseau un maximum de gaz renouvelables, y compris l'hydrogène, soutenir ces nouvelles filières et contribuer ainsi à l'atteinte de la neutralité carbone.
