Carbon neutrality by 2050 - European H2 strategies and scenarios

H2: A LOW-CARBON AND RENEWABLE ENERGY VECTOR FOR CARBON NEUTRALITY

Strong interest (production AND consumption) at local, national and European levels

Industries, mobility: substitution for fossil fuels underway

LOOKING AHEAD TO H2 TRANSMISSION

The challenge of **developing uses**

Logistics needs to be planned well in advance to optimise the costs of the H2 transmission and storage system COLLABORATION BETWEEN EUROPEAN TSOs

Common transport needs working together with adjacent TSOs

Joint **planning** of the **European H2 network**

Possible conversion of existing pipes at a lower cost


Transmission of CH4 and H2 alongside one another






